**TO THE PARENTS/GUARDIANS AND OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS:**

The staff of the Clermont County Detention Center understands the concerns you have regarding your child's residency in Detention. This form is an effort to answer some of the questions you may have regarding your child's stay in our facility.

**PURPOSE OF DETENTION:**

Detention is a temporary placement for young people within a secure facility pending court adjudication, disposition or placement. The detention setting is one of neutrality and there are expected rules of conduct for the children and the professional staff.

**EXPECTATIONS FOR RESIDENTS:**

All of the residents are oriented to follow the rules and expectations of behavior. They are expected to abide by the regulations of the facility. All Youth Leaders are trained to handle any questions or problems in a dignified and professional manner.

**PROVISIONS FOR RESIDENTS:**

Three (3) meals per day are provided in the detention dining area. The juveniles are also given an evening snack. All clothing is provided along with daily laundry service. Showers are given daily. Combs, toothbrushes, toothpaste, etc., are provided.

**PROGRAMS:**

Educational Programs are provided five (5) days a week. All children in the facility are required to attend.

**RECREATION:**

Outside basketball court, television, educational games, and computers.

**MEDICAL:**

The facility provides a physical examination for each resident by a registered nurse/LPN as well as on site/on call medical services 24-7. Emergency services rendered by Mercy Hospital Clermont, 3000 Hospital Drive; Batavia, Ohio 45103.

**TELEPHONE CALLS:**

Residents are permitted to call parents, guardians, clergy, lawyers, or caseworkers (limit two (2) calls per week and each call is limited to five (5) minutes). No incoming calls are permitted.

**VISITING BY APPOINTMENT ONLY:**

Visitors enter through the front entrance. Visitors are limited to parents and guardians. We reserve the right to request identification. Have identification on your persons. **YOU MAY VISIT TWO (2) TIMES A WEEK. VISITS ARE FOR A HALF HOUR (30) MINUTES.**

Regular visiting days and times are:

Saturday and Sunday	1:00 P.M. to 3:30 P.M.
Thursday	6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.
Holidays	1:00P.M. to 3:30 P.M.

# **DRESS CODE FOR VISITORS**

Visitors must be dressed appropriately. Any detention staff determining a visitor is dressed inappropriately may ask the visitor to leave the detention center.

1. No halter tops or spaghetti straps.
2. No **SHORT** shorts or **SHORT** skirts.
3. No crop tops.
4. Shirt and shoes must be worn.

**READING MATERIAL:**

Do not bring items into the facility for your child's use other than school books. Any other books or magazines which are brought into the facility are considered donated and become the property of Detention.

**CONTRABAND:**

No cigarettes, dip, lighters, smoking paraphernalia, weapons, or potential weapons are to be brought to the facility. These materials, if brought in, will be confiscated and not returned to the youth.
