- All information on the attached forms must be completed in full.
- You may type, print, or clearly write the information on the forms.
- If you are not already a party (mother, father and current legal custodian are examples of parties to a case), you must complete the Motion to Intervene which is included in this packet. The Motion to Intervene must be granted before the modification motion can be scheduled for hearing.
- YOUR PAPERWORK CAN NOT BE PROCESSED IF WE DO NOT HAVE COMPLETE AND CURRENT ADDRESSES FOR ALL PARTIES. THE COURT WILL IN NOT PROVIDE YOU WITH AN ADDRESS FOR ANY PARTY.
- The paperwork can be completed and turned in at the window OR you may take it with you and return it by mail.
- If you send the paperwork by mail, your signatures must be notarized. The address to send paperwork to is:

- Once your paperwork has been processed, you will be notified by mail of the date and time of your hearing. If your hearing notice is returned marked “undeliverable as addressed” and you have not notified the Court of your new address in writing, then your motion may be dismissed.
- If the hearing notice which has been sent to any other party is returned to the Court marked “undeliverable as addressed”, you will be contacted by the Court for a new address. It is your responsibility to provide a good address in writing to the Court as soon as possible. If you fail to provide a good address, and the motion has not been served at the time of hearing and the other party does not appear at the hearing, the motion may be dismissed.

- The staff at Juvenile Court is not permitted to give you legal advice. Examples of legal advice are:

What are my rights?

What will the Magistrate or Judge do?

Can I take the child from the other parent?
